Scholarships For Community Leadership

Available to all students across Canada who are now in their final year of high school (outside of Quebec) or final year of CEGEP (in Quebec) in the 2007/2008 school year.

2007/2008 Application Form

Important

A complete application consists of the following elements:

- this application form, fully completed and signed;
- an essay by you, of up to 500 words in length, describing the community leadership involvement(s) on which this application is based. Briefly outline what motivated you to undertake this activity, what you feel was accomplished, and what you learned from the experience;
- a letter of recommendation from your school, written by a senior official, such as your principal, guidance counsellor, or teacher;
- three letters of support or confirmation from the community group, groups, or individuals who have been the focus of the community leadership involvement on which this application is based. *If there are exceptional circumstances whereby three letters cannot be provided, you may include a letter detailing those special circumstances;*
- a transcript of your academic record;
- an essay of up to 250 words in length, describing your family and personal circumstances (family employment, economic situation, challenges, etc.), or other extenuating circumstances that may be relevant to your application;
- an essay of up to 250 words in length, detailing your activities if you have taken a year or more away from high school or CEGEP.

No other material will be presented to the judges. Materials cannot be returned.

All applicants will be notified in writing by the end of February 2008 as to their status.

Applicants selected as finalists will be notified by mid-January 2008, and interviewed by a selection panel in February. Scholarship recipients will be notified soon after.
