Important business documents you will need to provide when applying for a TD Business Credit Card for your Small Business

If your Small Business is new to TD:

- ✓ Master Business License:
 - Required for Sole Proprietorships or Corporations operating under a trade name
- ✓ Partnership Agreement: for Partnerships
 You will need to bring the Partnership Agreement to provide information about your business, including information about who can sign on behalf of the Partnership.
- ✓ Articles of Incorporation: for Corporations

 You will need to bring the Articles of Incorporation for your business to provide information about your business, including information about who can sign on behalf of the Corporation.

The following may also be required:

√ Notice of Assessment (last 2 years):

You will need to provide income confirmation for your business by bringing your Notices of Assessment issued by the federal government to your business after your business taxes have been paid.

Business Financial Statements:

You will need to provide copies of the financial statements for your business in support of your TD Business Credit Card application.
